The answer is found in more than one place.

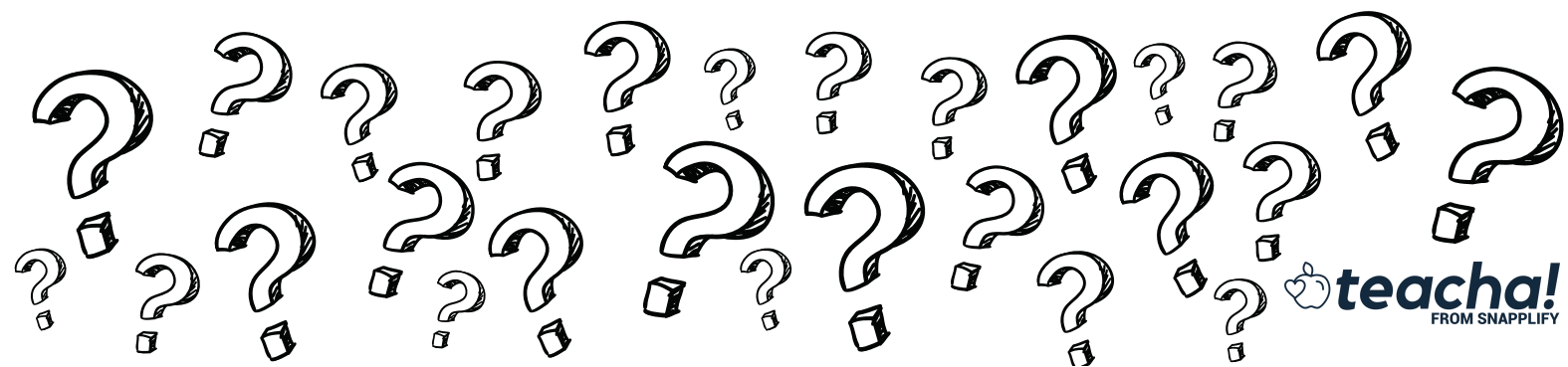

You need to read the text and use your own knowledge to answer the questions.

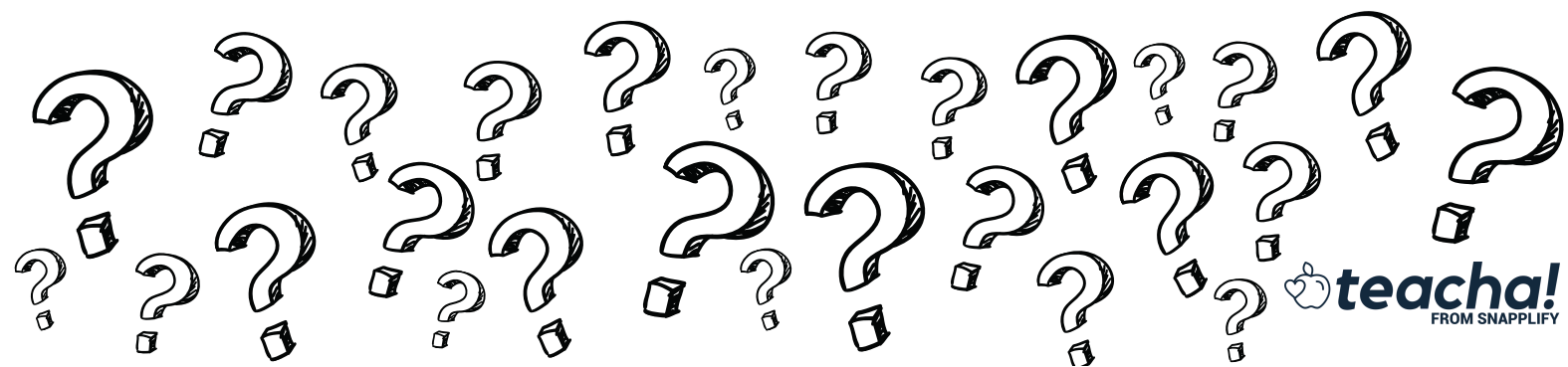
